Marmion Primary School P&C represents our parents and the wider school community. It works closely with the school Principal, administration and teaching staff to positively contribute to our children's education by raising funds to increase learning opportunities, improve school resources, support common goals and promote community spirit.

The Marmion P&C is an affiliate of the WA Council of State School Organisation (WACSSO), established under the Education Act for the purpose of supporting a strong government school system to benefit all students at the school.

Our P&C meets 6 times a year in the school library, all parents are welcome and encouraged to attend the meetings. The P&C meetings are a great way to find out what is happening at the school and have your say in the ways funds are raised and spent.

All money raised by the P&C is spent to directly benefit our kids at Marmion. Over the past few years the P&C has been able to contribute nearly \$150,000 back to the school in the form of playgrounds, sporting equipment, iPads, technology leases, Literacy Pro, bike racks, book week authors, canteen equipment and uniforms, library shelving, bushland plants, recycling centres, woodworking and science benches.

Parent participation and involvement is crucial for the successful operation of the P&C. There are many ways to support the P&C from holding an Office Bearer role, being on the executive committee, volunteering for the Your move initiatives, the garden club, supporting fundraising and events, in the canteen and uniform shop. We encourage all families to get involved in whatever capacity you can.

Technology Fund

We are very fortunate to have a well supported technology fund at Marmion which means that parents do not need to supply and maintain devices for their children.

Voluntary contributions are paid annually per year and directly contribute to the technology available at the school for all students in all learning areas. We encourage families to contribute to this fund via the Campion Education booklist. This fee is currently \$50 per student or \$70 per family.

Your support of this program is appreciated and in 2023 it meant the P&C was able to approve \$22,000 to be spent on new iPads, and \$9,000 to cover technology leases which will directly benefit our kids learning in all classrooms.
