One of our character strengths is **leadership.** Leadership skills allow children to have control of their lives and the ability to make things happen. Leadership instils confidence, and helps children solve problems creatively, work in a team, and work collaboratively with others. Leadership gives children many opportunities to develop responsibility.

9 tips to help teach a child leadership skills:

Build their confidence – confidence is key to developing the trust required to lead. Check out the blog, <u>6 Tips to build confidence in children</u>, for help on building confidence!

Improve their communication skills

Help them get good at something – creating a competence will make leadership easier. Leading by example is a good way of creating followers.

Encourage them to share ideas - sharing ideas and visions with friends, teammates, and family helps to create a shared vision.

Promote persistence – set goals and stick to a plan.

Ask them to share in a sacrifice – teach leadership by displaying it as an act of getting your hands dirty and joining in with something that is a challenge. This teamwork will help build trust and influence.

Ask them about a role model they may have – ask them about the qualities they admire about them and why.

Encourage them to admit fault – if they can learn to admit fault when making an error, it will allow them to gain & build the trust required to be able to lead and influence.

Encourage them to avoid criticism – criticism is the quickest way of breaking rapport and trust. Even if someone has done something wrong, ask them to find a way of informing that person that doesn't involve criticism.

PROCESS FOR P&C FUNDING PROPOSALS

The P&C provides funding for numerous initiatives and projects around the school each year.

The P&C raises funds via our Fundraising Committee through a variety of events over the year, for example The Evening on the Oval, Mothers/Fathers Day stalls & Sports day. This is how we can provide funding to support the school.

If there is something you are passionate about that you think the school will benefit from or would like to coordinate an event for a purpose, whether it be new play infrastructure, IT equipment or recycling bins, you will need to submit a Funding Proposal to the P&C for discussion at a General Meeting.

We've set out a step by step process to assist in getting your Funding Proposal approved.

- Speak to the School, (first stop Mr Boylan our Principal) to put forward your idea, confirm the need and get their approval.
 When you have this, then...
- Research suppliers and try to get at least three quotes if it's an item you wish to have the P&C purchase for the School.
- 3. Liaise with the P&C to see if any grant opportunities would be available if applicable (e.g. could Lottery west provide some funding?).
- 4. Request the appropriate forms from the P&C for your funding Proposal to include the above information and confirm the content with Mr Boylan prior to submitting to the P&C.
- 5. Submit all relevant information to P&C 10 days prior to P&C meeting.
- 6. Be prepared to answer questions at the next general meeting to discuss your Funding Proposal.
- 7. Once approved you may proceed with your Proposal and ensure all receipts are provided to the P&C Treasurer for reimbursement of the approved amount.



Rest assured the process is not always complex and once the need and process is established, repeat approvals are often far quicker.


