Character Strengths

What is Zest?

Zest is one of our character strengths that we focus on at Marmion. Zest means approaching a situation, or life in general, with optimism and energy, not approaching tasks or activities halfway or half-heartedly.

Zest is a dynamic strength that is directly related to physical and psychological wellness. This strength has the strongest ties to overall life satisfaction and a life of engagement. So what does developing zest look like in the learning process?

Teachers leverage kids' innate ability to learn by creating and maintaining environments that encourage their zest and curiosity and support their feelings of autonomy.

At Marmion we believe in framing mistakes as opportunities for learning and discussion, and we celebrate questions to drive learning. We also believe in kids having some ownership of the direction their learning takes.

For families it's important to bear in mind that some children are not as naturally "zestful" as others. With these learners especially, keep in mind that enthusiasm isn't taught as much as it is modelled and encouraged. Enthusiasm is infectious. If kids see your zest for learning, they can be inspired too. The goal is to help kids move along the spectrum of enthusiasm toward a more zestful attitude.

Gravity defying stunts steal the show!

Our Ride2School event today was full of excitement as the stellar riders from Freestyle Now showed off a range of jaw-dropping tricks.

There were aerial manoeuvres and technical skills on display. The BMX riders jumped, backflipped and spun over the half pipes onto the airbag landers.

There was overwhelming enthusiasm from the students, who cheered and high-fived riders as they rolled back through.

The event included road safety messages, with the coaches noting serious accidents are avoidable by wearing a helmet.

Afterwards, 40 students from Year 3 to 6 took part in foundational BMX skills sessions. Students learned techniques to stand and ride over ramps. More experienced students practiced hands-free moves, while others gained confidence in their abilities through practising in a supportive environment.
